From the Desk of Pastor Katie

July is now upon us. I've found myself thinking lately about the past year and how much has changed. It was a year ago, on July 12, that we gathered together for the first in-person worship since March. We had made the decision to close down in-person worship on March 22. The time between March and July felt like way more than just 3 months and 20 days. It felt like more than just 112 days. It was 16 weeks, 2688 hours, 161,280 minutes; it was 30% of a calendar year.

The pandemic has been extremely challenging for many of us. So very many of us have been impacted by COVID-19. Losses of jobs, livelihoods, and lives of loved ones...the pandemic, I think, has highlighted loss in so many ways.

And yet, the pandemic has also highlighted the way communities and communities of faith can come together (distantly!) in times of trial and suffering. It showed us that we can gather for worship even if we are not gathered together in the flesh. It showed us that caring for others means caring for all others, even those who are unknown to us. It showed us that we are part of the body of Christ whether we are dispersed or not. And it showed us how to continue our mission as the church, in this community and in communities distant.

Very little of the change was ideal. Modifying how we worship and then modifying it again has been challenging. It was difficult to make decisions that meant we had to look the pandemic in the face and deal with it. It was so very difficult to gather again for worship in-person, only to suspend it again 3 months later. It was difficult to not celebrate Christmas in our sanctuary, to not sing together our beloved Christmas hymns.

And yet, Christmas 2020 was one of the more holy ones in my memory. It was nothing like I've imagined or even experienced before. And it was a precious, precious gift.

We are still traveling down this road. COVID-19 is still real, and it has the potential to affect again how we worship. But even if it does, it does not have the capacity to change who we are, what we believe, who we follow and worship, and to what we've been called to do and be in the name of Christ.

It's easy to focus on what we've lost, but I think it's also worth listing and noting what we've

gained because of this. I'll add a few of my own thoughts, and I invite you to share your thoughts with me as well.

The pandemic: what we have gained:

- A new ministry partner
- Different ways of worshiping
- New music and new musicians
- How precious Holy Communion is when it's taken together
- New ministries
 - The food pantry
 - Gas and grocery cards
 - Virtual worship attendance from all over the country and even some from other counties!

I would love to hear what some of your thoughts are. I am, as always, grateful and blessed to be walking beside each of you and communally as the congregation of St. John Lutheran Church Maxfield.




I didn't forget your birthday or anniversary. I just wanted to help prolong the celebration! Happy Belated!
